**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
COUNCIL FOR ECONOMIC EDUCATION
AND
UNIVERSITAS NEGERI JAKARTA**

The Council for Economic Education (formerly National Council on Economic Education), the United States of America, and Universitas Negeri Jakarta, Indonesia, agree to enter into a formal exchange agreement based on the foundation of mutual trust for the mutual benefit and development of the two institutions and the promotion of understanding. The areas for cooperation are as follows:

1. The two institutions agree to jointly develop some or all of the following activities:
 - a. Building partnership in promoting economic and financial literacy;
 - b. Capacity building for the Indonesian Council on Economic Education and its University center network;
 - c. Nominating participants to take part in Training for the Trainer, Training of Writers, US Study Tours, and US Study Tours for Education Leaders programs run by the Council for Economic Education;
 - d. Developing orientation and fact-finding activities;
 - e. Organizing joint international conferences, workshops, and cultural activities;
2. The implementation of each exchange based on this agreement shall be separately negotiated and determined by both institutions and efforts shall be made by both sides to find financial sources for carrying out the exchange programs.
3. Nothing shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution nor will any constraints be imposed by either upon the other in carrying out the agreement.
4. This Memorandum shall commence on the date of its signing and shall remain in effect for a period equal to the Council for Economic Education's external international program funding cycle and can be reviewed and renewed annually.
