

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
PEARSON FOUNDATION
AND
UNIVERSITAS NEGERI JAKARTA**

Pearson Foundation and Universitas Negeri Jakarta (UNJ) agree to enter into a formal exchange agreement based on the foundation of mutual trust for the mutual benefit and development of the two institutions and the promotion of understanding. The areas for cooperation are as follows:


1. Pearson Foundation intends to undertake a program of scholarships for UNJ (the Pearson Scholarships) to help build capacity in educational research across the globe. The Pearson Foundation will:
 - make an annual commitment of US\$8,000 towards the scholarship program;
 - commit to maintaining this funding for a period of three years;
 - require the scholarships to be granted to up to 4 PhD scholars; and,
 - provide the funding directly to UNJ following annual Board approval of payment for each year
2. Universitas Negeri Jakarta (UNJ) will:
 - promote the scholarships to prospective students;
 - facilitate the application process;
 - review the applications with the normal rigor involved in approving PhD research topics; and,
 - select the most appropriate candidates


Nothing shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution nor will any constraints be imposed by either upon the other in carrying out the agreement.

This Memorandum shall commence on the date of its signing and shall remain in effect for a period of 3 years subject to annual review, at which both parties shall by mutual agreements determine the terms and conditions of any extensions of duration of the Memorandum.
