

**General cooperative Agreement
Between
Yangzhou University
&
Universitas Negeri Jakarta**

In order to advance friendly relations between China and Indonesia, Yangzhou University and Universitas Negeri Jakarta join in the following agreement on the promotion of educational and academic exchange between the two universities.

Both institutions will make every reasonable effort to encourage direct contact and research cooperation between their faculty and staff members, and research institutes, to the extent that they are able, under provisions of the agreement, to cooperate in the fields with which both parties are concerned.

Both universities agree on the following general forms of cooperation:


1. Joint research activities
2. Exchange of academic materials and academic publications
3. Exchange of faculty and staff members
4. Exchange of graduate and undergraduate students
5. Exchange of administrative staff members

Themes of joint activities and the conditions for utilizing the results achieved and arrangements for specific visits, exchanges, and other forms of cooperation will be negotiated for each specific case.

Both universities understand that all the financial arrangements should be negotiated and will depend upon the availability of funds.

It is understood that the implementation of this agreement will commence from the date of signing and that this agreement will continue thereafter for five (5) years, subject from time to time to revision or modification by mutual agreement. The possibility and the terms of a renewal of the agreement will be discussed by the representatives of the two universities no less than six months prior to the natural termination of the current agreement.



Intercollegiate Cooperation Agreement

Country INDONESIA University UNIV. NEGERI OKTA

Country China, University Yangzhou University

In order to enhance the educational capabilities of each of the above institutions, it is proposed that collaborations and exchanges be initiated in fields of common expertise and interest. The programs to be initiated through this agreement will be based on a spirit of cooperation, reciprocity, and of mutual benefit to both parties.

1. Both institutions agree to pursue academic collaboration in various areas of education, research, and extension.

2. Both institutions will make good-faith and enthusiastic effort to promote program collaboration, exchange faculty, scholars, and students, as well as educational, research, and extension materials appropriate to the areas of collaboration.

3. Specific details of exchanges noted above will be negotiated between the institutions subject to the approval of each institution.

This agreement will remain in effect for five years from the date of signing, and is renewable thereafter for five-year terms subject to mutual consent. This agreement may be terminated by either party by giving at least six months notice in writing to the other party.
