


Academic Integrity










ACADEMIC INTEGRITY VIOLATION PROCESS


1. Student receive a warning letter on academic integrity violation.



2. Student should meet the teaching staff and academic staff. 361 responses




3. As a consequence of academic ethic violation, the student score is reduced. 361 responses




1. Student ask somebody to check the paper before submission.
























